Eligibility and General Information

1. Applicant must be graduating from a high school in the Payson School District during the current school year.
2. Applicant must have a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA. Attach a sealed copy of your official high school transcript.
3. Applicant must provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher. The letter should address the applicant's abilities, leadership, personality, and integrity.
4. Applicant must provide a letter of recommendation from an employer (current or former) or someone familiar with but not related to the applicant. The letter should address the applicant's work, service, and leadership in the community.
5. Applicant must complete the essay questions, each one limited to a maximum of 250 words.
6. Fillable applications can be obtained on our website: rimcountrymuseum.org. Non-fillable applications can be obtained on the Payson High School website. If applicant does not use the fillable form, applications must be typed.
7. **Applications must be received by April 1. No late applications will be accepted.** Scholarship awards will be announced in May. Questions may be directed to: ngchs82@gmail.com or Rebecca Fillerup at 928-978-6603.
8. This scholarship is payable upon acceptance and enrollment of the student in an accredited college, university, or vocational school. Upon notification of enrollment, the check will be presented to the student.
